

## CHESHIRE CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS 2010

Following work by the co-host organisers and the referee in conjunction with Reaseheath College, the championships have been re-arranged for Saturday, 13<sup>th</sup> February, using the same time table and order of races.

This change of date has a number of implications:

1. As the new date is after the official closing date for entries for the Inter-counties, Adrian Thiemicke has obtained their agreement that entries will be accepted from Cheshire PROVIDED they are received by the CAU on Sunday 14<sup>th</sup> February. This will have to be done electronically. It is imperative therefore that those runners given forms on the day at Reaseheath hand them back, completed, to the relevant team manager BEFORE they leave Reaseheath.
2. Any athletes who are unable to run on the new date and wish to be considered for a discretionary **entry**, must notify the relevant team manager BEFORE 13<sup>th</sup> February.
3. The entry secretary (Stephen Whincup) is willing to receive additional entries provided they are received by **6<sup>th</sup> February**.
