**MEETING INFORMATION**

The meeting will be held under UKA Rules. EA Licence No: OUT 26/099.  
Competitors in all events must wear Club / County / Regional / National / colours.

To be eligible to compete in the Cheshire County Championships athletes must:

- Have been born within the 1 April 1974 Cheshire county boundaries (incl. Halton & Warrington) or have lived within this area continuously for the last 9 months.
- Have not competed in another English County Championship or Welsh or Scottish Regional Championship in this competition year.
- Have not competed for another English County or Welsh or Scottish Region in this competition year.
- Be registered with their National Association through their Club membership.

All entrants shall be deemed to have made himself/herself/themself, familiar with, and agreed to be bound by the UKA Anti-Doping Rules and to submit to the authority of UK Anti-Doping in the application and enforcement of the Anti-Doping Rules. The UKA Anti-Doping Rules apply to entrants participating in the sport of Athletics, for 12 months from the date of entering the event, whether or not the participant is a citizen of, or resident in, the UK.

By entering, athletes are deemed to have given permission for their photograph to be taken during competition and accept that it may be used for website and promotional purposes by Cheshire County AA and/or England Athletics.

**Age Groups:**

U12s must be at least 9 years old on the day and under 12 years old on 31/08/2026.

U14s must be 12 or 13 on 31/08/2026.

U16s must be 14 or 15 on 31/08/2026.

U18s must be 16 or 17 on 31/08/2026.

Entries will only be accepted for a maximum of 3 events per day for the above age groups.

U20s must be 18 or over on 31/08/2026 but under 20 on 31/12/2026.

Entries will only be accepted for a maximum of 5 events per day for this age group.

**Athletes must only compete in their own age group in these Championships.**

Medals will be awarded to the first three in each age group in each event, irrespective of the number of entries. Events will only be cancelled if no entries are received by the closing date. The published draft timetable may be amended when entry numbers are confirmed after the closing date.

Entries will be via the England Athletics competition Roster entry system. Entry Fees are £5 per event for U12s and £8 per event for all other age groups plus a £1.50 meeting fee, which includes Roster transaction fees, per athlete. **Entries close on Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> May.** Entry fees, less the meeting fee, may be refundable at the discretion of the organisers prior to the closing date for entries.

U12s will get three trials in throws and horizontal jumps. All other ages will get three trials in throws and horizontal jumps and the top eight a further three trials. Photofinish and electronic timing will be used in track events and EDM in field events.

Personal best and season best performances are requested to assist with seeding. If it is a new event for you please enter a best guess to allow seeding.
