## INFORMATION FOR COMPETITORS

The venue is about a mile to the east of Kelsall Village on the A54 Middlewich Road, close to the junction with the A556. Please drive carefully in the Equestrian Centre where there is ample parking.

Within the Equestrian Centre you are welcome to use the Urchin's Kitchen café, where hot and cold food and drink will be available.

Numbers, grouped by Club, can be collected from the reception area of the main building, where the café is located.

Club vests must be worn and headphones must not be worn.

The venue is primarily an equestrian centre but there are also cattle in some areas. Please stay away from the buildings, other than the café and toilets, and any fields where cattle may be grazing. Please make sure you take all your property and rubbish home. Dogs are allowed on the site but must be kept on leads and dog poo must be picked up.

Race information will be announced over a PA system and competitors will be called to the start approximately 10 minutes prior to each race. A warning gun will be fired 5 minutes before the start of each race.

We are expecting very cold weather and possibly snow by the end of the week. Please come prepared and keep an eye on the [Cheshire Athletics Facebook](#) page for any updates.

**Medal presentations** will be held as soon as possible after each race close to the finish area. Please listen for announcements over the PA.

**Awards** will be given to the first three male and female individuals in each non-veteran age group.

Veteran awards will be given to the first three in each of the following age categories:

Male 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74 & Over 75

Female 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69 & Over 70

**Teams:** Awards to the first three teams in each non-veteran age group and first three overall veteran teams.

Senior men 6 to count; Vet men 4 to count; All other races 3 runners to count.

Veteran men and women can count towards both the senior and veteran teams.

Veteran teams comprise of athletes from any veteran age group.

### **Inter County Cross Country Championships.**

The County Championships are the designated selection races for the Cheshire team at the Inter County event at Wollaton Park, Nottingham on Saturday 7th March.

The first 6 finishers in each race (except U/11, as there is no Inter County event for that age group) will be guaranteed selection for the Inter Counties, with a couple of places to be selected by the relevant Cheshire team manager. Anyone finishing in the first dozen or so places will be handed a letter asking if they are available if selected.

If you are handed such a letter, please ensure you return it (even if you don't want to run) to the relevant team manager, preferably that same day, so that they don't have to chase you up for it.
